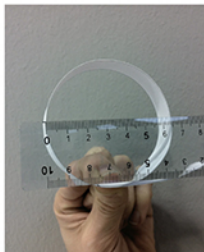
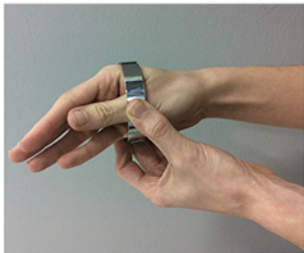
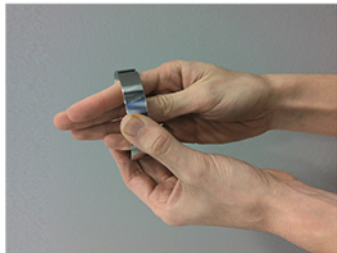


IT IS SLIGHTLY HARDER TO FIND THE RIGHT SIZE FOR A BRACELET THAN FOR A RING. YOU CAN ALWAYS ASK A JEWELLER WITH A BRACELET SIZER, WHICH WILL TELL YOU THE SIZE OF BRACELET THAT YOU NEED (IN MILLIMETERS) ALTERNATIVELY, YOU CAN FOLLOW THE RULES BELOW.

THE BRACELETS BY JeS-Titanium Design ARE RIGID AND CANNOT BE OPENED. THEY MUST BE PULLED OVER YOUR HAND TO BE WORN, SO THE IMPORTANT MEASUREMENT IS NOT THAT OF YOUR WRIST BUT THAT OF YOUR HAND AT ITS WIDEST POINT. IT IS THIS POINT THAT MUST FIT THROUGH THE INSIDE OF THE BRACELET WHEN YOU PUT IT ON.

MEASURE THIS PART OF YOUR HAND WITH A STRIP OF PAPER THAT YOU HAVE PREPARED IN ADVANCE. LOOP IT TO CREATE A BRACELET SHAPE AND CHECK THAT YOUR HAND FITS THROUGH IT, THEN MEASURE THE DIAMETER OF THE CIRCLE THAT YOU HAVE CREATED AND FIND A BRACELET MEASUREMENT THAT IS THE SAME OR SLIGHTLY LARGER THAN IT.

n.b. This measuring technique can be much less precise than using a bracelet sizer at a jeweller's because paper can lose its shape and therefore give inaccurate readings.
